Day 1, Krakow

- └ Overnight in Krakow



Day 2, Krakow

- └ Morning: search for souvenirs or shop at one of the regular malls
- └ Afternoon: visit Wieliczka Salt Mine; it is an exceptional tour that leads through chambers, galleries and caverns, and all carved in salt. Scheduled tour that you join is in English and return transfers are provided.

- └ Transfer to Krakow Balice Airport for your flight or to Krakow Główny Railway Station
