Day 1

- Arrival in Warsaw and transfer to your hotel for check-in
- Time at leisure
- Welcome dinner served at a local restaurant

Day 2

- Breakfast at your hotel
- Meeting with a local guide for a full day sightseeing tour of Warsaw, including Old Town with Castle Square (entrance to the Royal Castle included), the Royal Route: Krakowskie Przedmiescie, Nowy Swiat and Aleje Ujazdowskie, with numerous churches (Holy Cross Church where Chopin's heart is held), monuments, historic buildings and palaces; today many of them serve as embassies and ministries
- Lunch at local restaurant
- Continue to Lazienki Place and Park Complex featuring the Royal Palace on the Isle, former Royal Residence; today it is a museum which houses 140 works of art from the King's collection. The Complex includes the Old Orangery with the Royal Theatre - one of the very few original European 18th century court theatres. Lazienki Park is also known for the famous Chopin's monument and Belvedere Palace – one of the best restaurants in the city.

Day 3

- Breakfast at your hotel
- Meeting with your guide for a tour of Wilanow Palace - one of the most beautiful architectural monuments in Warsaw
- Afternoon at leisure to explore Warsaw on your own – choice of over 90 museums, numerous galleries and other attractions; the city is also a perfect place for shopping

Day 4

- Breakfast at your hotel
- Check-out and departure transfer to Warsaw Okęcie Airport
